Expression of interest from amongst Public Officers and Public Sector employees to perform duties as Environment Protection Officer at The Malta Environment & Planning Authority [MEPA]

In accordance with clause 3.1 of the current Collective Agreement, nomenclatures denoting the male gender include also the female gender.

1. In line with the concept of job mobility across the wider public sector, which enhances the learning experience of the individual whilst addressing the exigencies of the public sector, expressions of interest are being sought from suitable public officers to perform duties as cited above, for a period of three years definite contract with probationary period of one year and with the possibility of renewal.
2. Eligible Officers are thus invited to submit their expression of interest to perform such duties. Eligible Public Officers on secondment / on loan to Public Sector Organisations may also apply. Applications must be invariably submitted through the Head of Department / Entity for information purposes only. Successful Public Sector employees must make their own arrangements for their release prior to accepting any contract.
3. Applicants must be in possession of a recognised first degree in a relevant scientific, environmental, engineering field, mechanical / environment engineering or equivalent as applicable to the post. Applicants must have two years relevant career experience following graduation, preferably in developing and application of environmental policy including enforcement procedures.
4. Within delegated authority, the duties, amongst others, include
 - To contribute to the achievement of sustainable environmental improvement by developing environmental policy and regulation, monitoring environmental parameters and controlling activities with risk to the environment.
 - To identify areas of environmental importance and to liaise with local bodies, organizations, authorities and other interested parties towards the drawing up and implementation of relevant management programmes.

- To provide support to senior officials in the preparation, interpretation and proposed application of established objectives including the formulation of environmental policy and regulation.
- To act as a team member with other staff in ensuring that the necessary tasks are implemented as well as that all delegated obligations are being complied with.

5. The salary attached to the position of Environment Protection Officer is €21,174 x 442.59 - €23,386.91. In the case of a selected candidate holding a substantive grade in the Malta Public Service, for the purpose of the 1937 Pensions Ordinance (if applicable), the difference between the salary to which the selected candidate is entitled by virtue of the substantive grade and the salary of the position will be paid as a non-pensionable allowance. The successful applicant will resume the duties of his/her substantive grade once he/she reverts back to the Public Service /Public Sector.

6. The selected candidate shall, for the period during which he/she is performing such duties, be accountable to the Team Manager / Unit Manager / Assistant Director, and other Senior Staff where he/she is deployed.

7. The period during which the selected applicant is performing duties as Environment Protection Officer at MEPA shall be reckonable as 'service in the grade' for the purpose of computation of length of service, seniority, salary, progression and, where applicable, for treasury pension purposes. The performance of such duties will also be acknowledged in the Record of Service (GP47) applicable to public officers.

8. Eligible applicants will be requested to attend for an interview to assess their suitability to carry out such duties.

8.1. Qualifications and experience claimed must be supported by certificates and/or testimonials, copies of which should be attached to the application or sent separately to the HR Manager, MEPA, St Francis Ravelin, Floriana, by the closing date. Scanned copies sent electronically on miriam.b.abela@mepa.org.mt are acceptable.

8.2. Original certificates and/or testimonials are to be invariably produced for verification at the interview.

8.3. It is the responsibility of the applicants, in possession of qualifications awarded by Maltese or foreign Universities/tertiary education or other institutions (excluding qualifications awarded by the University of Malta, Malta College of Arts, Science and Technology, Institute of Tourism Studies and Institute for Conservation and Management of Cultural Heritage) to produce a recognition statement on comparability of qualifications issued by the Malta Qualifications Recognition Information Centre (MQRIC) within the Ministry of Education, Culture, Youth and Sport or the designated authority, as applicable, which statement should be attached to the expression of interest and the original presented at the interview.

9. Submissions, including a detailed C.V. and a Service and Leave record form (GP 47)), together with documentation from HR unit of the entity he/she is working with, which clearly indicates that the candidate is a full time employee together with

current grade and salary, are to reach the Human Resources Manager, MEPA, St Francis Ravelin, Floriana by not later than noon (Central European Time) of Friday 30 July 2010

10. Submissions received from abroad through a fax or other similar message by noon (CET) of Friday 30 July 2010 may be considered provided that all requisite details are given. The formal expression of interest duly signed by the applicant must reach the Human Resources Manager, MEPA, by not later than one week after the closing date with an explanation for the delay. 11. Selected Officers will be required to sign an undertaking signifying their commitment to the assignment for which they are selected.
